## **FEF UNVEILS SAVE A FIRST RESPONDER**

**MORGANVILLE, NJ, JULY 10, 2012:** The Firefighters & EMS Foundation (FEF), a coalition of National Police Defense Foundation (NPDF), announced the establishment of the "SAVE A FIRST RESPONDER" program, a law enforcement initiative to deter criminal activity that victimizes Firefighters, EMS and related first responders.

According to FEF Administrator Vincent Tummino, "Over the years there has been an increase of criminal activity that resulted in the death of firefighters, EMS and related first responders. The "Save a First Responder" program will post a \$10,000 for public information that leads to the arrest and conviction of any person whose criminal acts that includes arson results in the death of an on-duty first responder".

The Firefighters & EMS Foundation was established in January 2011 to better protect the interests of firefighters and EMS personnel nationwide. The FEF program services are being administered by retired FDNY Firefighter Vincent Tummino who volunteers his services.

In addition to the "Save a First Responder" program, the FEF has also implemented several child safety and related programs that include helping to fund "Camp Wonder", which is a one week camp in Livermore, California for severely handicapped children with life threatening skin disorders.
